Match Information

This is a CPCA Registered Match. All CPCA rules and classifications apply. Unclassified shooters will be classified as GRAND MASTER. It is the responsibility of each participant to **present his or her most current CPCA membership card.**

1. All competitors must be members of CPCA for **2018**. CPCA memberships will be available at the match. Entries close at 1230 hrs. August 11, 2018
2. Relays will be called starting at 0830 hours until all shooters have completed the course of fire.
3. PPC 1500 match 1-5 is an OPEN EVENT (either revolver OR semi-auto), Duty Gun match 1-5, Snub Nose revolver, Dist. Revolver and Dist. Semi-Auto. Team Match - 2 person team matches for both PPC and Duty Pistol will be match 5, main match score
4. B27 targets will be used on all matches. Targets will be available by the stairs.
5. Eye and ear protection is mandatory at all times while on the range.
6. Challenges and protests are to be made in accordance with the procedure outlined in the CPCA rulebook. The challenge fee is \$3.00. The decision of the referee is final. There will be no scoring plugs used except by the referee as per rule 14.11. The scoring area will be posted.
7. Cash prizes, based on total numbers of competitors will be awarded in the PPC Indiv. Match, Duty Pistol Indiv. Match and Snub. The Team prize will be first place only in each class. Classes will be combined if there are not enough teams in each class.
8. Lunch will be available at the RWF clubhouse at midday.
9. Hamburger Bar-B-Q and awards presentation will follow the match at the RWF clubhouse on the property, beginning at approx 1815 hrs.
10. Pre-shoot for the PBS match committee – August 10, 2018. RCMP Cadets - CPCA Duty Gun Match to be held on .August 18, 2018.

Directions to range:

From Regina, Victoria Ave.eastbound : on #1 highway from Regina to the Pilot Butte turnoff approx. 7km. Look for the Pilot Butte exit, right off #1 highway. Then follow bridge interchange over #1 which will take you north. Coming down off the interchange approx. 500m ahead take the first right. Follow its winding route to the north Service Rd. and continue 3 km east to the turnoff for the Regina Wildlife Federation 1.6 km north.

From Winnipeg, on #1 highway westbound, look for the Pilot Butte exit on the right. Follow to the top of the interchange, turn right to Pilot Butte and approx. 500m from the interchange take the first right turn. Follow its winding route to the north service road. Continue approx. 3 km east to the turnoff for the Regina Wildlife Federation.

From Regina North Industrial area: on #46 highway, proceed east until you see the first turnoff on the right for Pilot Butte, approx... 7 km. Proceed south on the access road until you are approaching #1 highway overpass interchange. Approx. 500 M from the over pass there will be a left turn. Follow its winding eastward route until you reach the north service road. Follow the N.S road until you come to the turnoff for the Regina Wildlife Federation

THEN, when you see the pale yellow RWF Sign turn left (North) and proceed for 1.6 km.
RWF range is on the right...

The range is in yards facing N/E. 16 shooting positions with turning targets. No overhead cover.
