



Abbotsford Fish & Game PPC 2024 Annual General Meeting Report

With 2024 coming to a close, the Abbotsford Fish and game PPC sub club celebrates 42 years of continuous monthly PPC competitions held on the first Sunday of the month with the later year competitions being sanctioned by CPCA. We are looking forward to year #43 of holding matches on the first Sunday of the month in 2025.

We are fortunate enough at the Abbotsford club to be able to shoot all year round with covered shooting positions that have radiant heaters for every 2 shooting positions and even snow doors to keep snow out of the range and reduce the amount of cold winds entering the range when some of the shooting positions are not being used. The range has large LED lighting that allows us to shoot until 10:00 PM 7 days a week.

In October we ran two matches on the first weekend of October, by cosponsoring matches on October 5th where the POCO club (Port Coquitlam District Hunting and Fishing Club) moved their regular monthly CPCA match to the Abbotsford Fish & Game range, and the Abbotsford club ran our regular first Sunday of the month CPCA match on October 6th. These matches served as warm up matches for the Canadian National Championships held a week later in Victoria. For the warm up matches we were able to welcome two competitors from Australia, 3 competitors from Ontario and Alberta, all of whom attended the Nationals.

In 2025 we have reserved the Abbotsford range for 10 CPCA sanctioned matches to be held on the first Sunday of each month, with the exception of April and December, on which we hold our Easter and Christmas Turkey fun shoots.

We hope to see PPC shooters from across Canada at our monthly matches in 2025, should any of you happen to be in the lower mainland on our shoot dates.
